<u>KEY AREA OF LEARNING</u> - GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

. During this term, the children will go beyond the boundaries and will find out what is out in space and in our solar system. They will learn about the planets and use digital maps to look at the moon. We will also find out about the 'Space Race' and the first moon landings.

SCIENCE

Earth & Space. We will be describing the movement of the Earth and other planets, relative to the Sun, in our solar system. We will look at the movement of the moon relative to the Earth. We will describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as roughly spherical bodies and finally, use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

ENGLISH

We will be looking at another William Grill non-fiction book called 'The Wolves of Currumpaw' this term. It is, again, based on true events and lends itself to persuasive letter and diary writing whilst developing a range of reading skills. It is beautifully illustrated and is an informative, interesting text.

We will begin with E-Safety focusing on Self-image & identity & how it can be copied, modified or altered. Then, in computer science, we will investigate repetition in programs, work with variables & various forms of input & output.

This term we will be alternating with tag rugby, indoor athletics and large ball skills.

Our weekly forest school sessions will be on a Monday afternoon - starting after the half term. They will alternate with P.S.H.E half termly.

FRENCH

During this term we will be focusing on being able to talk about the days of the week, simple greetings, telling the time
