

# It's All Greek to Me! YEAR 3 Star Class

## SCIENCE

First of all, we will be studying fossils, their formation, old as well as new discoveries. This will be followed by an investigation into soils – their properties, the different types, and their significance. After, we will study forces and magnets - what they are, how they work and how they are a part of our everyday life.

In Spring 2, the class will learn about light and shadow, undertaking experiments into what makes a shadow and how materials are affected by light.

### ENGLISH

In English we will be studying Greek myths. We will work on inference, summarising and story end writing. The class will write their own version of a myth.

Following these, we will turn to The Selfish Giant by Oscar Wilde for character and setting descriptions. In addition, the class will explore the viewpoint of the giant and the children in the story through diary writing tasks. We will continue to work on comprehension and reading skills plus SPAG and handwriting.

### GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

During the Spring term, we will be studying Ancient Greece and what life would have been like during those times compared to today. We will study daily life, important achievements and events as well as Greeks influence on the western world. Year 3 will learn about sources and how we can use different evidence to help us understand what life was like in the past. We will also use different maps to learn where Greece is in the world and the geographical features of this country in addition to working on improving our map skills. We will study the traditions and culture of Greece and the people to develop our understanding of this historically significant country.

### MATHS

During Spring, Year 3 will be focusing on multiplication and division, looking at the formal methods for multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers by I-digit numbers. Other concepts to be studied will include money, length and perimeter and measure.

In addition, a huge part of learning in Year 3 is developing a much greater recall of the Timetable facts. We will be focusing on our 2,3,4,5,8 and 10x tables.
