SCIENCE

Our unit of work is sound and electricity this term. We will learn to identify how sounds are made, recognising that they are caused by vibrations, and explore how these vibrations travel through different materials. When learning about electricity learn to identify common appliances that run on electricity.



KEY AREA OF LEARNING - HISTORY

Our key area of learning this term will be in History where we will complete a detailed study of the Romans & the British invasions. Features we will be focusing on include key event throughout the Roman era, sequencing events on a time line, looking at BC & AD & the impact the Romans have had Britain. We will investigate types of settlements & land use throughout this era & how the Romans changed Britain forever. We will also be focusing on cities around the UK and investigate how the Romans linked them.

ENGLISH

This term we will be studying
Kennings and List poetry as well as
The Iron Man. Learning outcomes
will include a variety of original
poetry, storyboards, and 3 course
menus for an Iron Giant!

MATHS

In maths, pupils measure and compare lengths, calculate perimeters, and solve related problems, following White Rose Maths strategies. They deepen understanding of fractions by recognising equivalents, performing operations, and solving practical problems. Pupils also explore decimals, linking them to fractions and money, supported by visual models and reasoning tasks.

HOMEWORK

Children are expected to read daily and use TTRS weekly.

Spellings will be set and regularly tested. There will be a topic project list where children are expected to select one option to complete.

COMPUTING

We will be studying the area of Creative Media firstly creating podcasts using Audacity before continuing with Photo editing. We will begin to look at programming.

PE

PE this term will focus on personal challenges in Vortex, Speed Bounce, Standing long jump & Vertical jump.

Focus: Indoor Athletics and Dodgeball.

FRENCH

Children will work on how to say personal information about themselves such as name, age and birthday. We will look at colours, body parts and family members: hobbies, pets and whether they like or dislike something.

MUSIC

We will be looking at pairing Haiku's with music to depict the Japanese festival of Hanami. We will continue to look at the history of music.

PSHE/SMSC

Social – Teamwork within class, particularly through the creation of our drumming music which involves whole class cooperation.

Cultural – Looking at how Myths and Rituals differ around the world.

Moral – Looking at the moral implications of the developments to our country by the Romans
